Candidate Contract and Terms of Participation

- Participants must be 17 years of age but no older than 21 (as of June 15, 2018) and must live, work, or have attended high school in Brooklyn Park.
 (Park Center Senior High/Champlin Park Senior High)
- 2. Participants must be single, never having been married, nor be pregnant or have any dependents.
- 3. Candidates have the right to opt out of being selected as an Ambassador if they so choose.
- 4. Race, religion, outer beauty and economic status have no bearing on being selected as an Ambassador.
- 5. College plans will NOT prevent candidates from becoming an Ambassador as long as they are available during the summer months. School comes FIRST!
- 6. Scholarships of a-yet-to-be-determined amount will be awarded to each Ambassador at the completion of their year of service provided they have followed the code of conduct and contract rules.
- 7. A team of Ambassadors will be selected by a panel of judges (from outside the City of Brooklyn Park).
- 8. Ambassadors that are selected will be asked to sign a code of conduct and contract that will state the rules and expectations of the position they have been chosen to fill. If an Ambassador breaks contract rules, the

Brooklyn Park Ambassador Committee will meet to determine an appropriate consequence.

- 9. Candidates are expected to act with discretion at all times. Respectable speech and manner shall be maintained at all times. Zero tolerance for any underage consumption of alcohol and the illegal use of controlled substances shall not be permitted while the candidate is participating in the program. The Brooklyn Park Ambassador Committee expects candidates to maintain high standards while representing community sponsors and the City of Brooklyn Park.
- *10. Participants should be aware that Ambassadors are not allowed to have visible body art or piercings other than ear piercings. If selected, Ambassadors will be asked to sign a contract of conduct and agree to follow the rule.
