****UPDATE** Fatal Accident**

Brooklyn Park, MN – (March 17, 2020) Brooklyn Park detectives, along with Minnesota State Patrol, located the striking school bus involved in the pedestrian fatality. The adult male driver was arrested for criminal vehicular homicide and remains in custody.

Fatal Accident

Brooklyn Park, MN – On March 16, 2020, at 6:49 a.m., Brooklyn Park officers were dispatched to the intersection of Humboldt Avenue and Meadowood Drive on a report of a person down in the street. Responding officers located an adult female who appeared to have been struck by a vehicle. The female victim was found to have passed away on scene from her injuries.

An investigation is being conducted into the accident by the Brooklyn Park Police Department. Detectives do not currently believe that the original striking vehicle stopped at the scene. Detectives are looking for the public's help in identifying a school bus that was involved in this incident. Members of the public who may have any information on this incident are encouraged to call the Brooklyn Park Police Department.

Minnesota State Patrol and Hennepin County Sheriff's Office are assisting in this investigation.
