4.1 Green Step Cities Update

- Green Step is on back order, when it arrives there will be a virtual ceremony.
- There are five steps: the city is now working on step two.
- City will ask for assistance in identifying priorities for step three.

4.2 Speed Limit Policy Discussion

- Presented by Jesse Struve.
- Overview of presentation for City Council Meeting on October 5, 2020.
- New legislation allows for cities to set own speed limits through set policy.
- Three policy options were presented.
- Estimated cost \$15-20,000 every 14 years.
- Councilmember Pha shared City Council discussion on need for city-wide policy.

- Discussion of CLIC recommendation for City Council:
 - Majority CLIC members are in favor of lowering neighborhood speed limit to 25mph on residential roads and class II roads (red and blue).
 - Majority of CLIC members are in favor of using the 50th percentile for class II roadways.
 - Majority of CLIC members are in favor of using the 50th percentile for arterial roadways.
- CLIC recommends care in community outreach and communications.
