The Chief's Multicultural Advisory Team is an engaged group of volunteers who advise the Chief of the Brooklyn Park Police Department on how to better serve, communicate with, and understand the many cultures that reside in, work in, or visit the city of Brooklyn Park.

The Chief's Multicultural Advisory Team meets monthly with Police personnel to discuss topics which are important to their communities, to build mutual trust, and open two-way communication. Additionally, team members may be asked to volunteer or participate in additional community engagement activities hosted by the police department, sit on promotional or hiring processes within the police department and or weigh in on proposed policies and procedures within the department.

The Chief's Multicultural Advisory Team members represent the diverse cultural, professional, and educational backgrounds within Brooklyn Park. We ask members to tap into their various skillsets and networks as part of their work on this team; to engage with neighbors, coworkers, students, clients, or anyone else to learn how the Chief's Multicultural Advisory Team can make progress on police/community relations.
