

Arbor Day Tree Sale



In celebration of Arbor Day, the City offers bare root trees at wholesale prices to residents.

About bare root trees

The trees are sold in bare root form. The average caliper size of these trees is 1 to 1.5 inches with an average height of 6 to 8 feet. These bare root trees do not meet newly constructed home landscape requirements of 2 inches. For best results these trees will need to be planted the same day they are picked up.

Price and ordering details

- All trees are at a flat wholesale price of \$60.00.
- Trees are on a first order basis
- Trees must be pre-paid
- Limit 10 trees per Brooklyn Park household
- 170 trees in total are available.

No refunds or replacements

The City does not assume responsibility for the successful transplanting of these trees. Weather conditions, methods of handling and aftercare govern the results. Trees will be sold with the understanding that if they arrive in good condition and are accepted, the city's responsibility ceases. Therefore, we do not give out refunds or replace trees that fail.

We do not give refunds for trees not picked up.

Deadline

Orders received after April 24, 2026, may not be accepted or filled, due to a limited supply.

Species available

Name	Example	Description
Apple, Honeycrisp 20 Available		<p>Produces exceptionally crisp and juicy fruit. Flavor is sweet but right for eating, cooking, or baking. Fruit generally ripens red and in September. One of the University of Minnesota's best apples. Not self-pollinating but is very resistant to apple scab.</p> <p>Height: 10-14', Spread: 8-10' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
Beech, Blue 10 Available		<p>This medium-sized tree may grow slowly 20 to 30 feet tall and 20 to 35 feet wide. The leaves are alternate with a doubly toothed margin and turn an attractive orange-red color in the fall. In early spring, yellow-green, male and fuzzy, yellow-green, female flowers mature. Use this adaptable tree in naturalized areas or along streams or ponds, as well as in urban settings. This is a wildlife-friendly tree perfect for a pollinator, children's or native garden, acting as a larval host plant, food source for mammals and birds and a cover plant.</p> <p>Height: 20-35', Spread: 20-35' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow, orange, red Zone: 3-9, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
Birch, River 10 Available		<p>River birch is a popular, fast-growing native tree for the home landscape. Attractive salmon-pink to reddish-brown bark exfoliates to reveal lighter inner bark. Dark green foliage turns a beautiful buttery yellow in the fall. This species is resistant to Bronze Birch Borer.</p> <p>Height: 30-45", Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Dark Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone 4-8, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
Crabapple, Showtime 15 Available		<p>The large, densely clustered fuchsia red flowers turn the branches into columns of lush color. Deep green foliage has red tones of its own, especially as it emerges. In fall, red fruits glisten among the bright orange and red leaves. Recommended as a replacement for 'Prairifire' by Ohio State University.</p> <p>Top reasons to grow Show Time crabapple:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Incredibly vibrant fall color, bursts totally into fiery orange. - Flowers are so densely clustered the branches are obscured! - Invaluable to wildlife as a nectar and food source. <p>Height: 15-20', Spread: 15-20' Foliage: Green, Purple, Fall Color: Orange Zone: 4-8, Exposure: Full Sun</p>

<p>Elm, Valley Forge</p> <p>8 Available</p>		<p>This National Arboretum introduction has tested best for Dutch Elm Disease tolerance, bringing hope for the return of the American Elm. Fast growing but a little wild in the nursery, it matures to form a stately vase shaped crown.</p> <p>Height: 40-70', Spread: 40-70' Foliage: Dark Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 4-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Ginkgo, Princeton Sentry</p> <p>10 Available</p>		<p>An all-male cultivar, this ornamental tree produces no fruit. Upright, columnar habit. Rich emerald leaves turn to an outstanding golden color in the fall. Extremely adaptable to a range of soils and conditions. Slow growing but extremely hardy and long-lived.</p> <p>Height: 40-50', Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Hackberry</p> <p>10 Available</p>		<p>Hackberry is used as a shade tree or a boulevard tree. It establishes easily and grows well in urban landscapes because of its wide soil adaptability and its tolerance of heat, drought, salt spray, wind, ice, and short-term flooding. The bark of hackberry provides year-round interest in landscapes. The fruit is a popular food for birds and small mammalian wildlife. Much of the fruit remains on the tree throughout winter until it is eaten by birds.</p> <p>Height: 50-70', Spread: 30-50' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Honey Locust, Northern Acclaim</p> <p>10 Available</p>		<p>Features pyramidal growth with a central leader. It is a thornless and nearly seedless variety that typically grows to 40-45' tall. Dark green leaves with ovate leaflets (1/2" to 1 1/2" long) cast a sun-dappled shade. Leaves turn an attractive yellow in fall.</p> <p>Height: 40-50', Spread: 30-35' Foliage: Bright Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-6, Exposure: Full Sun</p>

<p>Linden, American Sentry</p> <p>10 Available</p>		<p>American Sentry® Linden is primarily valued in the landscape for its rigidly columnar form. It features subtle clusters of fragrant buttery yellow flowers with tan bracts hanging below the branches in early summer. It has dark green deciduous foliage. The large heart-shaped leaves turn an outstanding gold in the fall.</p> <p>Height: 40-60', Spread: 25-30', Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Lilac, Ivory Silk</p> <p>15 Available</p>		<p>A selection of Japanese Tree Lilac with a more compact, dense growth and prolific flowering habits than other cultivars. Though it prefers moist, well-draining soil, this tree is highly adaptable and tolerant of other conditions as well. Large creamy white flower clusters bloom in mid-June attracts pollinators such as butterflies, hummingbirds, and more.</p> <p>Height: 15-25', Spread: 10-15' Foliage: Green Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun, Partial Sun</p>
<p>Maple, Firefall</p> <p>20 Available</p>		<p>Deeply cut foliage, exceptional cold hardiness, and bright red fall color are among the special attributes of this tree. A controlled cross of Beebe cut leaf silver maple and Autumn Spire red maple, this University of Minnesota release is a fast growing, bright performer for the North.</p> <p>Height: 40-50', Spread: 30-40', Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Orange-Red, Red Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Oak, Swamp White</p> <p>10 Available</p>		<p>Swamp White Oak grows to a large, majestic tree typically 50 to 60 feet tall with an equal or greater spread with a broadly rounded crown that provides excellent shade and a long-lived, stately presence in the landscape. Like all native oaks, it is an ecological keystone species of extraordinary importance: oaks support more caterpillar species (over 500 in the eastern United States) than any other group of trees, making them irreplaceable anchors for bird populations and entire forest food webs.</p> <p>Height: 50-60', Spread 50-60' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow, Brown Zone: 4-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>

<p>Serviceberry, Autumn Brilliance</p> <p>10 Count</p>		<p>Named for its notable fall color, Autumn Brilliance® is just as spectacular in the spring, with its abundance of showy, white flowers. The flowers give way to small green berries that gradually deepen into red. They finally mature a deep, rich purple in early summer. Sometimes referred as Juneberry, named for the annual summer time frame of the ripe berries.</p> <p>Height: 15-25', Spread: 15-25' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Red Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Spruce, Norway</p> <p>12 Count</p>		<p>The fastest growing of all the spruces. Develops strong graceful branches that are covered with dark green needles. Important habitat and food source for a variety of wildlife year-round. Aromatic – the needles of this spruce give off a distinctive “pine” scent with a hint of citrus. Ideal windbreaker. Resistant to pests and diseases and transplants well.</p> <p>Height: 40-60', Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Green Year-Round Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
