  - > The city has 100 properties that have racial covenants.
  - > 88 of the 100 reside in the northeast corner of the city (East District).
  - > The HRC felt that the community should be educated about this.
    - i. Potentially two meetings.
    - ii. The first meeting would be educational.
    - iii. The second meeting would be action orientated.
    - iv. Council Member Xp Lee stated that he could host a townhall meeting for residents, and he would issue the challenge of getting all 100 covenants discharged by June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
  - HRC members pondered on receiving information in the mail was the best way to notify residents that their home has a covenant attached to it.
