

Arbor Day Tree Sale



In celebration of Arbor Day, the City offers bare root trees at wholesale prices to residents.

About bare root trees

The trees are sold in bare root form. The average caliper size of these trees is 1 to 1.5 inches with an average height of 8 to 10 feet. These bare root trees do not meet newly constructed home landscape requirements of 2 inches. For best results these trees will need to be planted the same day they are picked up.

Price and ordering details

- All trees are at a flat wholesale price of \$49.00.
- Trees are on a first order basis
- Trees must be pre-paid
- Limit 10 trees per Brooklyn Park household
- 175 trees in total are available

No refunds or replacements

The City does not assume responsibility for the successful transplanting of these trees. Weather conditions, methods of handling and aftercare govern the results. Trees will be sold with the understanding that if they arrive in good condition and are accepted, the city's responsibility ceases. Therefore, we do not give out refunds or replace trees that fail.

We do not give refunds for trees not picked up.

Orders received after April 28, 2023 may not be accepted or filled, due to a limited supply.

Species available

Name	Example	Description
Apple, Honeycrisp 25 Available		Produces exceptionally crisp and juicy fruit. Flavor is sweet but right for eating, cooking, or baking. Fruit generally ripens red and in September. One of the University of Minnesota's best apples. Not self-pollinating but is very resistant to apple scab. Height: 10-14', Spread: 8-10' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun
Cherry, Evans Bali 15 Available		A self-pollinating compact fruit tree. During mid-spring it produces stunning clusters of fragrant white flowers followed by an abundance of bright red cherries. Ideal for backyard orchards or attracting birds to your yard. Height: 15-20', Spread: 10-15' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Orange Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun
Crabapple, Prairifire 10 Available		A showstopping ornamental fruit tree, this variety of crabapple is highly resistant to scab, rust, fire blight and Japanese beetles. Has an incredible display of fragrant, rich pink flowers in spring followed by purple fruit from fall through winter. Though technically edible, the fruit is usually beloved by songbirds. Self-pollinating and a good companion tree to cross-pollinate with other apples. Height: 15-20', Spread: 15-20' Foliage: Green, Purple, Fall Color: Orange Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun
Elm, Valley Forge 10 Available		An American favorite, this tree is fast growing and has an upright vase-like shape typical of elms, making it an ideal shade tree. Has excellent resistance to Dutch elm disease. Tolerates a wide range of soil types. Height: 60-70', Spread: 60-70' Foliage: Dark Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 4-7, Exposure: Full Sun
Ginkgo, Autumn Gold 10 Available		An all-male cultivar, this ornamental tree produces no fruit. Rich emerald leaves turn to an outstanding golden color in the fall. Extremely adaptable to a range of soils and conditions. Slow growing but extremely hardy and long-lived. This tree should be considered a heritage tree as it can live well over 150 years old under ideal conditions. Height: 40-50', Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun

<p>Honeylocust, Northern Acclaim</p> <p>15 Available</p>		<p>A seedless cultivar that produces minimal leaf litter, making this an ideal low-maintenance selection. This tree is resistant to disease, pollution, and drought – making it highly adaptable to both suburban and urban spaces. Casts filtered shade and produces showy golden leaves in the autumn.</p> <p>Height: 40-50', Spread: 30-35' Foliage: Bright Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-6, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Lilac, Ivory Silk</p> <p>15 Available</p>		<p>A selection of Japanese Tree Lilac with a more compact, dense growth and prolific flowering habits than other cultivars. Though it prefers moist, well-draining soil, this tree is highly adaptable and tolerant of other conditions as well. Large creamy white flower clusters bloom in mid-June attract pollinators such as butterflies, hummingbirds, and more.</p> <p>Height: 15-25', Spread: 10-15' Foliage: Green Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun, Partial Sun</p>
<p>Linden, Boulevard</p> <p>15 Available</p>		<p>Stunning shade tree with a strongly upright pyramidal form, clean habit, and fragrant yellow flowers in early summer. Good choice for attracting bees to your yard. Highly adaptable and tolerant of a variety of soils and conditions. The heart shaped leaves turn to vibrant golden color in the fall.</p> <p>Height: 50-80', Spread: 30-50' Foliage: Dark Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone 2-8, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Maple, Firefall</p> <p>10 Available</p>		<p>A hybrid of a red and silver maple. A great shade tree that has the best foliage qualities of its parentage - with noteworthy dark green elegant lacy leaves in the spring and summer, followed by a stunning fiery display in autumn. Extremely adaptable to a wide range of soil types.</p> <p>Height: 40-50', Spread: 30-40', Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Orange-Red, Red Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Oak, Crimson Spire</p> <p>5 Available</p>		<p>A beautiful hybrid chosen for its narrow growth habit. Dark green leaves turn to vibrant red in the autumn. Considered a heritage tree as it can live to be well over 100 years old. A good choice for attracting wildlife such as wood ducks, squirrels, deer, and turkey who favor the acorns this tree produces.</p> <p>Height: 40-60', Spread: 10-15' Foliage: Dark Green, Fall Foliage: Red Zone: 4-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>

Name	Example	Description
<p>Oak, Heritage</p> <p>5 Available</p>		<p>A large growing and stately hybrid oak with a distinctive and refined pyramidal form. This oak produces both acorns and shade – so it provides great habitat for wildlife. Tolerates a variety of conditions and soils. Can live to over 300 years old with ideal conditions – considered a heritage tree.</p> <p>Height: 50-60', Spread 35-45' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow/Green Zone: 4-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>River Birch, Heritage</p> <p>15 Available</p>		<p>A fast-growing tree prized for its peeling bark. Has a higher resistance to the bronze birch borer. This ornamental and accent tree has an oval growth habit and provides filtered shade. Thrives in a wide range of soils.</p> <p>Height: 40-50', Spread: 30-35' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 4-9, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
<p>Redbud, Northern</p> <p>10 Available</p>		<p>A strain of redbud developed by the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum to survive Minnesota's climate. Sought for its decorative properties this tree has interest year-round. Produces rose-pink to magenta flowers in early spring and has an orange hued bark that turns deep red with maturity. Resistant to deer but attracts songbirds and some insect pollinators.</p> <p>Height: 20-30', Spread: 15-20' Foliage: Green; Fall Foliage: Green-Yellow Zone: 2-4, Exposure: Partial Sun/Full Sun</p>
<p>Spruce, Norway</p> <p>10 Count</p>		<p>The fastest growing of all the spruces. Develops strong graceful branches that are covered with dark green needles. Important habitat and food source for a variety of wildlife year-round. Aromatic – the needles of this spruce give off a distinctive “pine” scent with a hint of citrus. Ideal windbreaker. Resistant to pests and diseases and transplants well.</p> <p>Height: 40-60', Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Green Year-Round Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun</p>
