



In celebration of Arbor Day, the City offers bare root trees at wholesale prices to residents.

About bare root trees

The trees are sold in bare root form. The average caliper size of these trees is 1 to 1.5 inches with an average height of 6 to 8 feet. These bare root trees do not meet newly constructed home landscape requirements of 2 inches. For best results these trees will need to be planted the same day they are picked up.

Price and ordering details

- All trees are at a flat wholesale price of \$59.00.
- Trees are on a first order basis
- Trees must be pre-paid
- Limit 10 trees per Brooklyn Park household
- 175 trees in total are available.

No refunds or replacements

The City does not assume responsibility for the successful transplanting of these trees. Weather conditions, methods of handling and aftercare govern the results. Trees will be sold with the understanding that if they arrive in good condition and are accepted, the city's responsibility ceases. Therefore, we do not give out refunds or replace trees that fail.

We do not give refunds for trees not picked up.

Orders received after April 28, 2024 may not be accepted or filled, due to a limited supply.

Species available

Name	Example	Description
Apple, Honeycrisp 30 Available		Produces exceptionally crisp and juicy fruit. Flavor is sweet but right for eating, cooking, or baking. Fruit generally ripens red and in September. One of the University of Minnesota's best apples. Not self-pollinating but is very resistant to apple scab.
30 Available		Height: 10-14', Spread: 8-10' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun
Birch, Whitespire 15 Available		The species is noted for its non-peeling chalky white bark, long-pointed triangular green leaves, upright form, non-exfoliating white bark, and attractive yellow fall color. This plant has many benefits including ease of transplant, that it casts light shade, and tolerates heat, wind, deer, and drought.
		Height: 20-40', Spread: 10-25' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun
Buckeye, Autumn Splendor 5 Available		An interesting accent tree for home landscape use, selected primarily for its outstanding fall color, features showy spikes of creamy white flowers rising above the foliage in mid spring. It has dark green deciduous foliage. The palmate leaves turn an outstanding tomato-orange in the fall. However, the fruit can be messy in the landscape and may require occasional clean-up.
		Height: 30-35", Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Dark Green, Fall Foliage: Orange red Zone 2-8, Exposure: Full Sun
Crabapple, Prairifire 25 Available		A showstopping ornamental fruit tree, this variety of crabapple is highly resistant to scab, rust, fire blight and Japanese beetles. Has an incredible display of fragrant, rich pink flowers in spring followed by purple fruit from fall through winter. Though technically edible, the fruit is usually beloved by songbirds. Self-pollinating and a good companion tree to cross-pollinate with other apples.
		Height: 15-20', Spread: 15-20' Foliage: Green, Purple, Fall Color: Orange Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun

Elm, New Horizon		This hybrid elm has slightly arching branches that give it a more finely textured appearance than most elms. It has excellent resistance to Dutch elm disease (DED), elm leaf miner, and verticillium wilt.
15 Available		Height: 30-40', Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Dark Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun
Ginkgo, Princeton Sentry	Wilson-Brend'archem.com	An all-male cultivar, this ornamental tree produces no fruit. Upright, columnar habit. Rich emerald leaves turn to an outstanding golden color in the fall. Extremely adaptable to a range of soils and conditions. Slow growing but extremely hardy and long-lived.
10 Available		Height: 40-50', Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone:3-8, Exposure: Full Sun
Lilac, Ivory Silk 20 Available		A selection of Japanese Tree Lilac with a more compact, dense growth and prolific flowering habits than other cultivars. Though it prefers moist, well-draining soil, this tree is highly adaptable and tolerant of other conditions as well. Large creamy white flower clusters bloom in mid-June attracts pollinators such as butterflies, hummingbirds, and more.
		Height: 15-25', Spread: 10-15' Foliage: Green Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun, Partial Sun
Honeylocust, Skyline		Features pyramidal growth with a central leader. It is a thornless and nearly seedless variety that typically grows to 40-45' tall. Dark green leaves with ovate leaflets (1/2" to 1 1/2" long) cast a sun-dappled shade. Leaves turn an attractive yellow in fall.

Name	Example	Description
Maple, Red Sunset 20 Available		Known as one of the best red maple cultivars. Medium to fast growing. Winter buds, clusters of small winter/spring flowers, leaf stems, twigs, and winged summer fruits all carry a red hue. Is known as one of the best cultivars for fall color.
		Height: 40-50', Spread: 30-40', Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Orange-Red, Red Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun
Oak, Bur 5 Available		A large growing and stately oak with a distinctive furrowed bark. This oak produces both acorns and shade – so it provides great habitat for wildlife. Tolerates a variety of conditions and soils. Long lived tree that is native to the Midwest.
		Height: 70-80', Spread 70-80' Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow, Brown Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun
Tamarack 5 Available		Beautiful native conifer that loses its needles in fall. It is commonly found in wet, swampy, or boggy locations, but can grow in other locations as long as soil moisture is consistent. This tree looks good through many seasons. In spring, small rosy pink cones can be seen as new needles begin to emerge. In summer, the soft green needles give the tree a fine texture. In autumn, the needles turn yellow before they fall. Height: 40-80", Spread 30-45"
		Foliage: Green, Fall Foliage: Yellow Zone: 2-5, Exposure: Full Sun
Pine, Eastern White 5 Count		The Eastern white pine is a tree for landscapes with ample space. Its fine feathery needles, open canopy, and straight trunk get more picturesque with age. Trees are fast-growing and long-lived.
		Height: 50-80', Spread: 20-40' Foliage: Green Year-Round Zone: 3-8, Exposure: Full Sun







Name	Example	Description
Spruce, Norway 10 Count		The fastest growing of all the spruces. Develops strong graceful branches that are covered with dark green needles. Important habitat and food source for a variety of wildlife year-round. Aromatic – the needles of this spruce give off a distinctive "pine" scent with a hint of citrus. Ideal windbreaker. Resistant to pests and diseases and transplants well.
		Height: 40-60', Spread: 25-30' Foliage: Green Year-Round Zone: 3-7, Exposure: Full Sun
