Self-Inspection Checklist

The following checklist is intended to help you evaluate *your* property prior to the city inspector conducting a sweep in your neighborhood. This list includes minimum Brooklyn Park ordinance requirements.

Yes	No	Does your property have one or more of these violations?
		Long Grass & Weeds (Ch.97) <i>(May be different during Slow Mow May)</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All grass and/or weeds must be shorter than 8 inches high.
		Junk & Debris (Ch. 94) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All garbage, junk, yard waste, litter, and animal waste must be properly disposed of or kept in a garbage can with a covered lid for pick-up.
		Waste Container Storage (Ch. 98) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All garbage, recycling and yard waste containers must be stored out of public view from the street.
		Inoperable Vehicles (Ch. 90) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All vehicles must have current license tabs displayed. Vehicles that do not run or drive cannot be stored outside for more than 48 hours.
		Unapproved Parking Areas (Ch. 152) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Motor vehicles must be parked on a paved surface. Parking motor vehicles on grass, dirt, rock, or landscaped areas is not allowed.
		Exterior Storage (Ch. 152) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Outdoor storage is not allowed except for recreational equipment and properly stacked firewood. All other items must be stored inside or removed from the property.
		Commercial Vehicles & Equipment (Ch. 152) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only one commercial vehicle under 15,000 lbs. and of certain body styles/types is allowed to be stored outside on residential property.
		Property Maintenance (Ch. 106) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All buildings, structures and fences must be maintained in good repair. Chipped paint or deteriorating surfaces must be painted or repaired.

Answering “NO” to all the items above means you are successfully maintaining the exterior of your property. Thank you for caring about your property and your neighborhood!
