Overview:

The City issued a request for proposals on May 13, 2024 to initiate the Northwest Growth Area Plan project for the creation of a small area plan, Alternative Urban Areawide Review (AUAR) and Development Implementation Strategy. At the August 26, 2024 meeting City Council approved the proposal by Bolton and Menk, Inc. at which time they began working on the project.

An Open House was held at the Brooklyn Park Small Business Center on January 22, 2025, with a survey following the material presented. This survey was also made available with all presented materials on the City website and was available to the public from January 22 through March 10, 2025. Consultants from Bolton and Menk, Inc. will be presenting survey results as well as 3 scenarios resulting from public input at this joint session with the Brooklyn Park Planning Commission.
