No paper bids will be considered. A bid bond for five (5%) percent of the amount of the bid, (to be forfeited as liquidated damages in the event that the bid be accepted, and the bidder shall fail to enter promptly into a written contract and furnish the required bond) is required to submit a vBid online through the QuestCDN portal.

Pursuant to the Brooklyn Park City Code, Chapter 42, this project is subject to prevailing wages as established by the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry in Minn. Stat. 177.41 to 177.44, and corresponding Minnesota Rules 5200.1000 to 5200.1120. Specifically, all contractors and subcontractors must pay all laborers and mechanics the established prevailing wages for work performed on this project. Failure to comply with the aforementioned may result in civil or criminal penalties to Covered Persons.
