

The City Council of Brooklyn Park has determined that pursuant to its City Code, Ordinance #2025-1318 be published in summary form.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE #2025-1318

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 127 OF THE BROOKLYN PARK CITY CODE
PERTAINING TO CANNABIS BUSINESSES

Ordinance #2025-1318 amends Chapter 127 pertaining to cannabis businesses and regulations. The ordinance amendment adds a limit of seven (7) cannabis retail registrations in Brooklyn Park and creates a lottery system for selecting future retail registration openings. The ordinance amendment also disallows amending a completed retail registration application. The limit of 15 LPHE registrations per city council district (45 maximum city wide) has been deleted per State law. The effective date of the ordinance is 30 days after its publishing in the City's official newspaper.

This summary of Ordinance #2025-1318 has been approved by the City Council on October 13, 2025. A printed copy of the full text of the ordinance is available for public inspection in the office of the city clerk.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its publication.
